Distinguished Professor and Chief Justice Earl Warren Professor of Public Law, UC Berkeley



Ian Haney López teaches and writes about race, law, and politics, currently focusing on the use of coded racism in electoral politics and its strategic connection to surging economic inequality and declining support for good government. His writing has appeared in the *New York Times* and the *Washington Post*, and in law reviews at Harvard, Yale, and Stanford, among other places. His research on racial politics features in his books *Dog Whistle Politics* (2014) as well as *Merge Left: Fusing Race and Class, Winning Elections, and Saving America* (2019), and also in his free online course, Race-Class-Academy.com. Ian holds the position of Distinguished Professor at the University of California, Berkeley, the institution's highest academic rank, and a chair as the Chief Justice Earl Warren Professor of Public Law.
